ENGLISH

Core Texts: Stories in familiar settings. Non-Fiction postcards and Letters. *Key Question: What is fiction and*

what is non-fiction? Children will also learn about Traditional poems.

Children will read and write their own version of a familiar story. They will ask questions to gain further understanding of the stories and predict the middle and ending of the story. They will continue to read daily.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Key Question: Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

Children will learn about Islam and what they believe about God and the examples set by Prophet Muhammad. They will look at the importance of families and communities and learn about the commonalities and differences in the celebrations. Children will share their celebrations.

MATHEMATICS

Areas children will learn this term:

- Money especially Uk currency.
- Problem solving and reasoning

- Measuring, length and mass

PSHE

Children will be reflecting and thinking about new beginnings. They will demonstrate their understanding of the 6rs and learn how to cope when things get difficult. They will use the Zones of Regulation to understand their feelings and how they can manage them.

Children will also learn further skills from the Life Bus sessions.
