Parents, guardians and carers are invited to attend four free online workshops via Zoom with Speech and Language Therapists from the Mainstream Schools Team. The workshops are short, practical training sessions that will take place between **Wednesday 20th and Wednesday 27th April** on topics including Language, Social Communication, Selective Mutism and Reluctant Talkers, and Early Communication Skills. ### Queen's Jubilee
