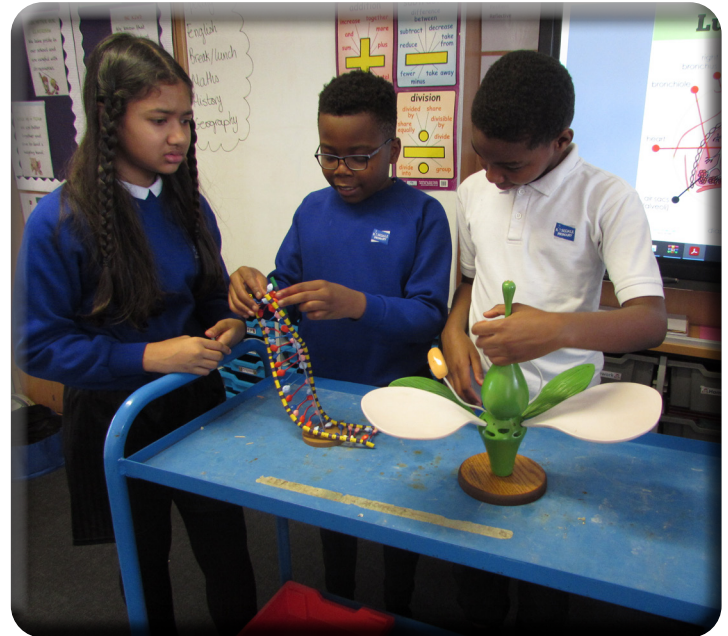
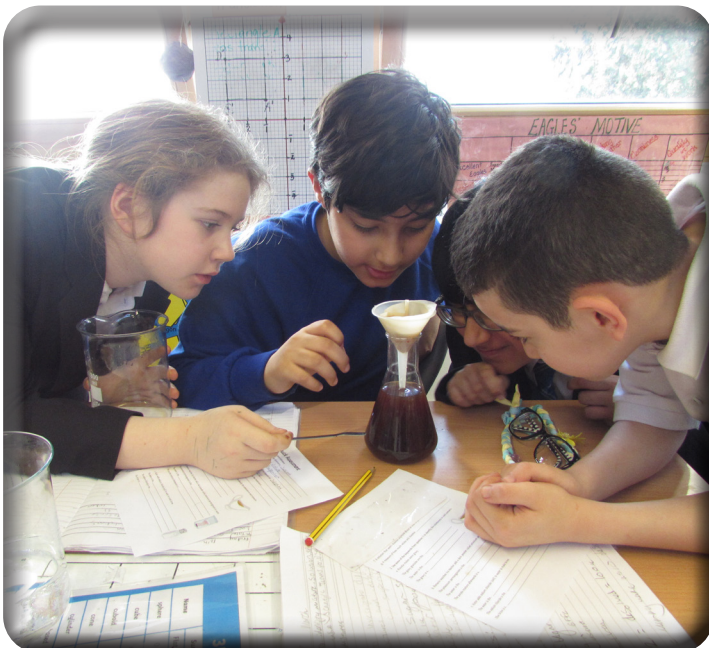




## Science Week
