The children were very eager to take part in all the fun learning activities with age specific programmes designed to aid the children in the acquisition of important decision-making skills regarding their health, build their self-esteem through inspiring enrichment experiences, and develop essential life skills.





#### **Precautionary Measures for Coronavirus**

As a result of the Prime Minister's plans to end Plan B restrictions, a number of changes have been made to the current coronavirus (COVID-19) measures implemented within the Trust following his announcement on Wednesday 19th January. A new national approach to daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 has been introduced. All adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 should take a lateral flow device (LFD) every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating. Additionally, the 10-day selfisolation period for those who record a positive polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test result for COVID-19 has now been reduced to 5 days in most circumstances.
