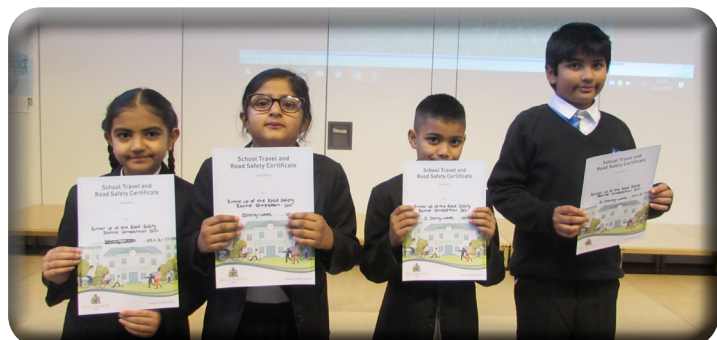


Road Safety Banner Competition
