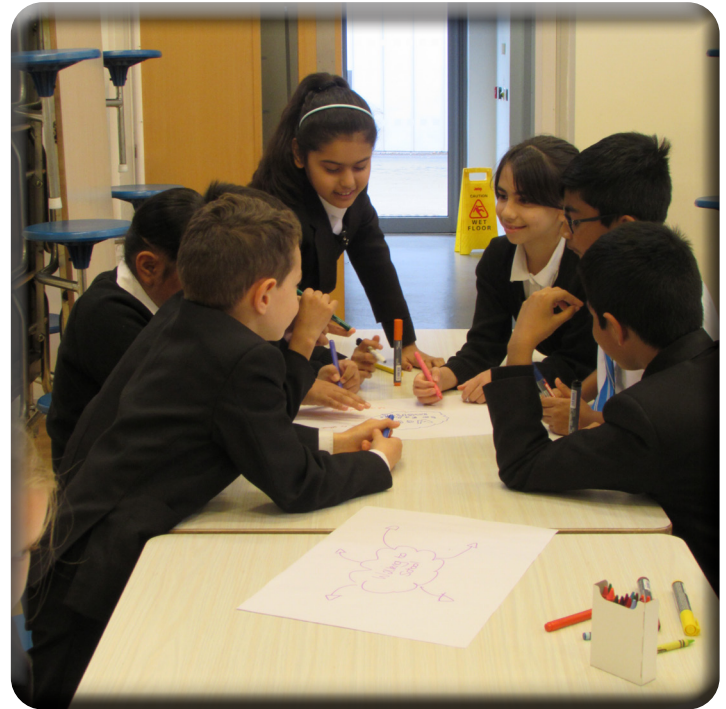
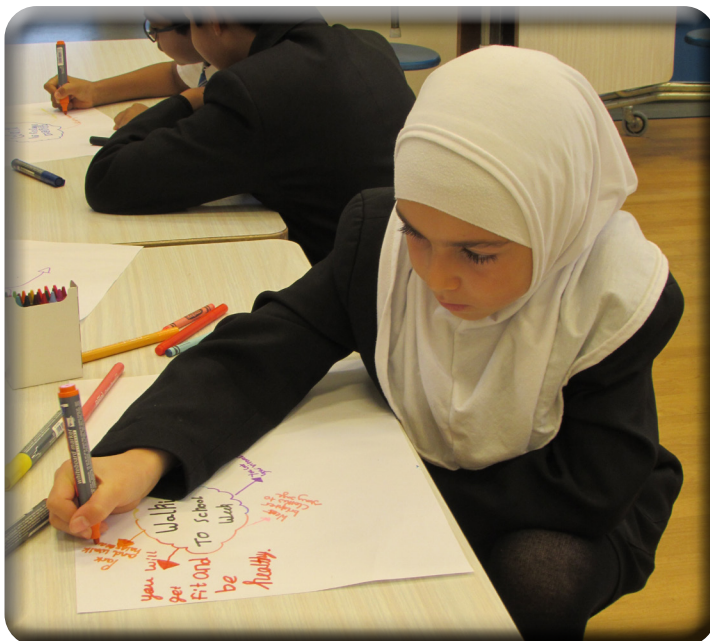

The skills set, expertise and commitment of each individual are fundamental, as the LAB is critical to the work of our schools and overall governance arrangements of The Trust. The School is eager to appoint two dynamic individuals as Parent Governors to support the School community in serving the entire pupil body to the best of its ability.
