

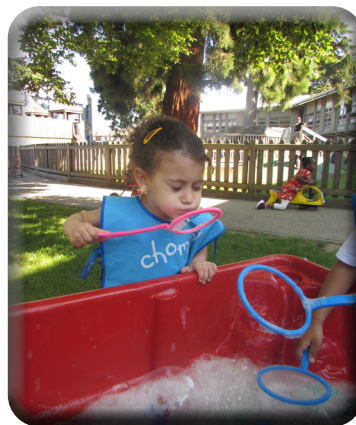
## New Nursery Parents Meeting
