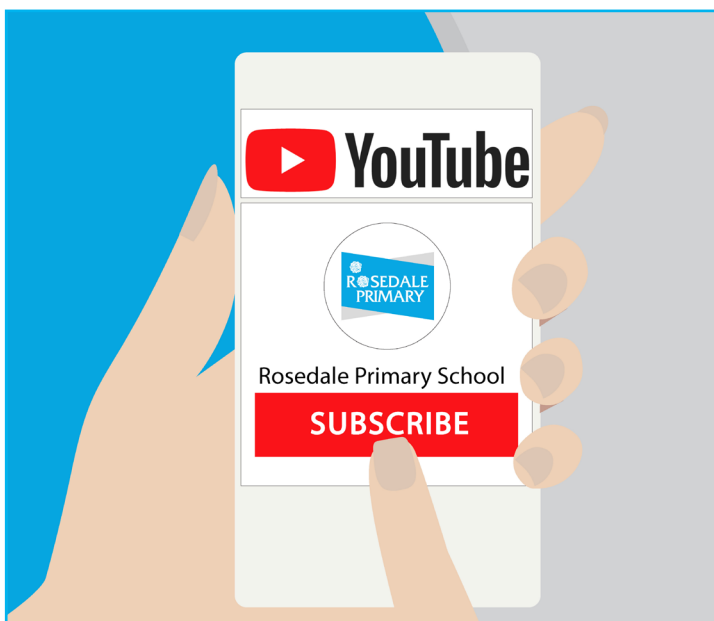
Tuesday 22nd June – Reception
