



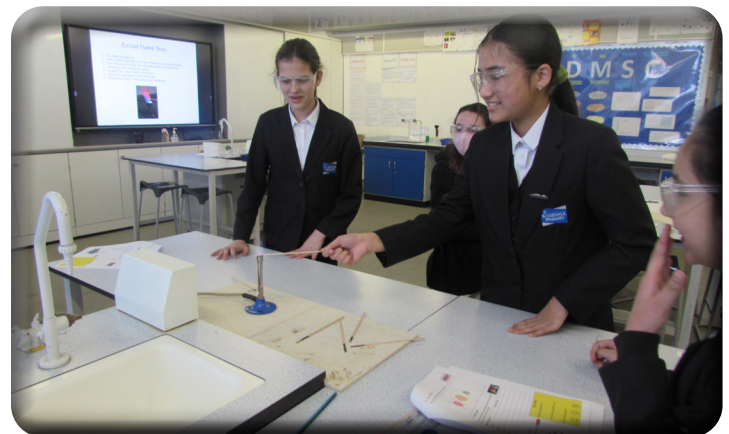
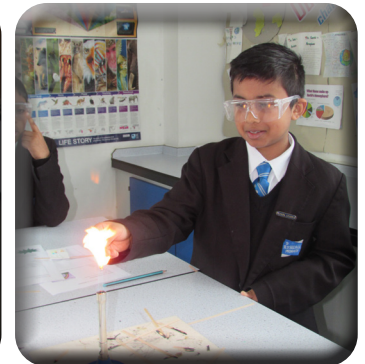
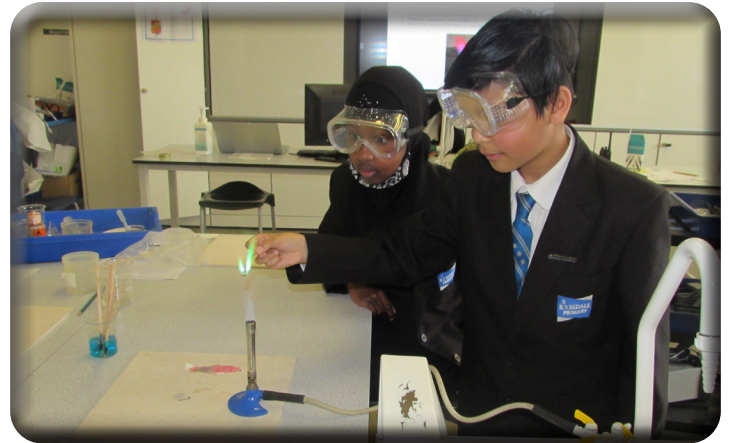
Incredible Eggs
