ENGLISH

Fiction and Non-Fiction - how are they different?

This is our House by Michael Rosen-Children will develop an appreciation for the different ways authors express themselves and how these can help develop writing skills. They will discuss the author and characters of the book, and learn how to:

- Describe the characters in the story;
- Predict events in a story based on pictures.

Children will continue to learn their daily Phonics, spelling and read for pleasure.

MATHEMATICS

Children will learn how to calculate.

They will learn about number and place value:

- More and less, subtraction and doubling;
- Recognising/exchanging using money;
- Reading number to 100, grouping in 10s and ordinal numbers;
- Counting in 2,s, 5s, and 10s;
- Calculations.

SCIENCE

Key Question: Why are certain foods eaten at different times of the year?

Children will continue to explore seasonal changes, this time through food.

What are Materials?

Children will learn that the materials we use can be classified into two groups, natural and manmade.

GEOGRAPHY: HISTORY

Geography Key Question: How has Hayes Town changed?

Children will learn about recognising and feeling positive about the effect of our natural world on our wellbeing, and responding and reflecting on our surroundings, both natural and humanmade.

History Key Question: Why do we recognise Remembrance Day?
Children will learn about community workers and their roles.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Key Question: Who is a Christian and what do they believe?

Year 1 children will continue to learn about Christian beliefs during this term. The children will share their own beliefs and celebrations. They will see similarities between their own faith and belief in God with other faiths just as Sikhism, Islam, Judaism.

PSHE

Key Question: What is democracy?

PSHE topic - Say no to bullying

Children will relook at their class rules and understand what it means to listen to others and share ideas. They will build upon the 6Rs and use the Zones of Regulation.

ART & TECHNOLOGY

Art: Children will use a variety of drawing tools including pens, charcoal, felt tip pens. They will experiment with pencils, lines of different shapes and thickness, tone and pattern. Children will work with natural materials and other materials to make collages as well sketching what they see in the environment around them including buildings in Hayes.

Technology: Children will design their Christmas props.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Key Question: How can I use the skills I have learnt in gymnastics to perform for an audience?

Children will continue with using their gymnastics skills to perform a short sequence. They will realise what positive criticism is and how they can improve.
