#### **Tomato Harvest**

On Monday 28th September, children in Years 2 and 3 learned new skills and gained special benefits, such as a midday snack, by harvesting the tomatoes that they had grown from sowing seeds in February! They were amazed by the variety of colours, shapes and sizes, and could not delay taste-testing the produce that they had nurtured, giving them a sense of pride and personal achievement. The crop ripened in late July with a range of heirloom, cherry and garden-zeus tomatoes, enabling our children to grow and harvest their own nutrient-rich produce!

#### **Parking Safely**

Whilst we appreciate that parents, guardians and carers are often very busy rushing to pick up or drop off children to school, we must ask you to think carefully about where and how you park your vehicles. Unfortunately, inconsiderate parking by some is becoming a concern outside Rosedale Primary as it is causing serious congestion and therefore is a hazard to children crossing the road at the beginning and end of the School day. Parking close to the School gates or double parking increases the risk of an accident because it reduces the visibility of children crossing the road to access or leave school. Therefore, use of this area for parking or turning any other vehicles around is strictly prohibited. Please park considerately and drive slowly when bringing your children to, or taking them home from school. We thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

#### **Dismissals**

The arrangements for parents, guardians and carers to collect their children require careful consideration to ensure that social distancing between families, staff and children is maintained. Families are reminded to adhere to the social distancing guidelines whilst on the school premises. Thus, once you have collected your child from school at their allocated dismissal time, please ensure that they remain by your side at all times. It is becoming increasingly difficult to dismiss the older children whilst the younger years are playing at the front of the School. Careful consideration should be given to ensure that ALL children are safe. Additionally, please remain behind the line and avoid approaching the grass area upon collection of Year 5 and 6 children. #### **Primary School Admissions 2021**

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017 that the closing date for applications for Primary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is midnight on Friday 15th January 2021. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period.
