As part of their Mathematics activity on Friday 11th September, the children in Year 1 enjoyed a lesson on 'Measuring' by using their handprints as a non-standard unit of measurement. ### Year 3 Physical Activity

The PE activities were planned in conjunction with their PSHE lesson on "My Body Needs...", allowing the children to remain captivated throughout. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period. ## Dropping off and Collecting Children Safely

Whilst we appreciate that parents, guardians and carers are often very busy rushing to pick up or drop off children to school, we must ask you to think carefully about where and how you park your vehicles.
