














New Reception

Free School Meals - Application Process

'Free School Meals' is a statutory means-tested benefit, which provides a child with meals at school for free. If you believe your child may be newly entitled to this benefit, or if they received it last year and you would like to reapply, please attend the School Office and request an application form. The School Office will also be able to advise any parents, guardians or carers who are unfamiliar with the process for claiming 'Free School Meals'. The Free School Meals benefit does not automatically renew; it must be reapplied for each academic year. It is important to note that until your child has been confirmed as receiving the Free School Meals benefit, their school lunches must be paid for.

IPayimpact

As you are aware, we have recently introduced IPayimpact which is an online payment system for lunch and uniform orders. As with any new platform, we are experiencing some delays in processing requests and we ask for your patience as we work with the providers to correct all issues.
