GEOGRAPHY & HISTORY

Key Question: What are the key features of non-chronological reports?

Pupils will continue to explore nonfiction text as well as fiction. Non-Fiction: Pupils will learn how to write non-chronological reports, information texts and newspaper articles.

Fiction: Pupils will read stories from other cultures.

In Mathematics Pupils will learn about:

- Addition and subtraction chains
- Expanded and column method
- 4 digit numbers
- Statistic and data handling
- Measuement of time and mass
- Geometry
- Fractions and decimals

Key Question: What are states of matter?

Pupils will learn about solids, liquids and gases. They will learn about changes of temperature and evaporation, and will undertake condensation investigations.

Pupils will also revisit the water cycle.

Geography Key Question: What are counties?

Pupils will use an atlas and undertake map work to learn about the UK and its counties.

History Key Question: What are social hierarchies?

Pupils will learn abut the Ancient Egyptians and the life of ordinary people.
