



YEAR SIX (6) AUTUMN TWO - WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD LEARN THIS HALF TERM?



ENGLISH

Key Question: Which types of information texts studied are the most reliable and accurate, and why?

Children will explore the different texts relating to the World Wars and learn about bias. Through this they will use their grammar, expanded noun phrases to convey complicated information concisely.

MATHEMATICS

Comparing and ordering fractions.

Children will add and subtract fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers using the concept of equivalent fractions.

All children will continue to learn their time tables up to 12, and solve problems using their place value skills.

SCIENCE

Key Questions: How much do you know about the Planet Earth?

What is day and what is night?

How has Electricity impacted our lives?

Children will recognise symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram, and use diagrams to build circuits.

HISTORY GEOGRAPHY

History Key Questions: How did people protect themselves during the World Wars?

Why and how was the contribution of Muslim soldiers, Sikhs and Hindus relevant during these times?

Geography Key Topics:

Children will learn the location of counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Key Questions:

Why do we need to consider the purpose of worship and its place in faith?

What is worshiping behaviour?

Children will learn the commonalties between Christianity, Islam, Sikhism, Judaism and reflect on ways of expressing appreciation in contexts other than religious.

PSHE

Key Question: What do we mean by dignity and respect, and what does it mean to act with dignity and respect?



DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

Key Topic: Portraits

Children will undertake sketching and drawing of portraits.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Key Question: How does catching, fielding and pitching enables fitness?

Children will learn about the importance of physical activity and health benefits.

MUSIC: Solo and ensemble contexts, using voice and playing instruments. FRENCH: Weather, seasons and geography of France. ER verbs.
