## **HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY**

#### **CORE TEXTS:**

Reading for pleasure, reading for life.

Key Question: Why do diary writing?

Children will build upon their range of writing by including adverbials, conjunctions, sentence structure, interjection and preposition.
They will also use punctuation.

Children will build their skills further in problem solving and calculator skills.

They will use the calculator and

reasoning skills to aid problem solving.
They will solve problems use logic and find patterns in numbers using multiplication and division.

Children will learn when the calculator is useful and when it is not necessary nor helpful.

Key Question: Children will revise light and electricity, thinking scientifically and using the key vocabulary to build their knowledge further.
