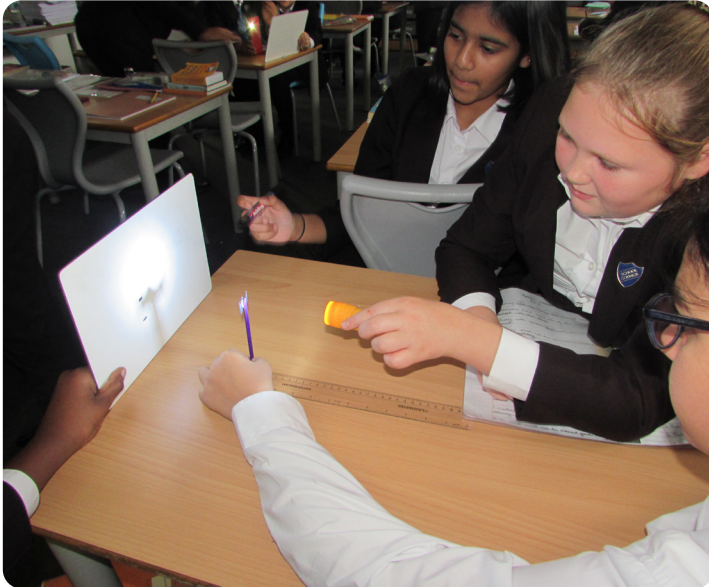




Electricity Project - Year 6

The activity aims to improve pupils' knowledge and understanding of electricity whilst at the same time enhancing their practical making and problem-solving skills as well as embedding learning of: Conductors and insulators, Circuit diagrams and electronic symbols, Circuit components including switches and buzzers and Circuit design and problem solving.
