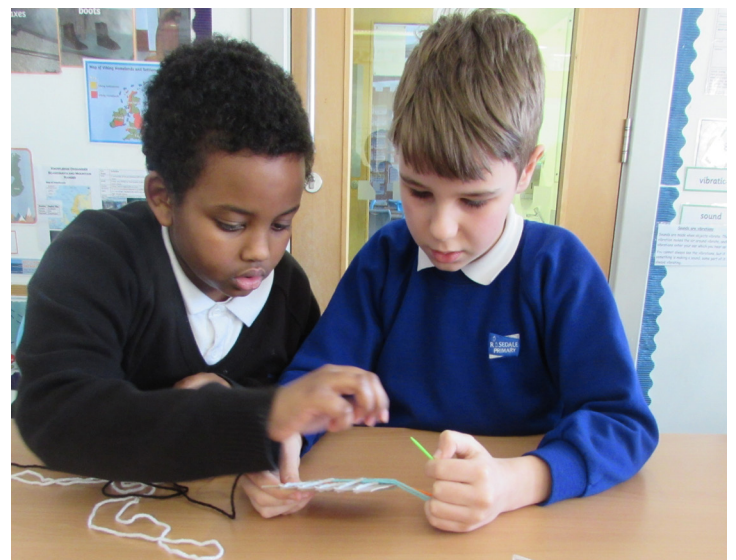
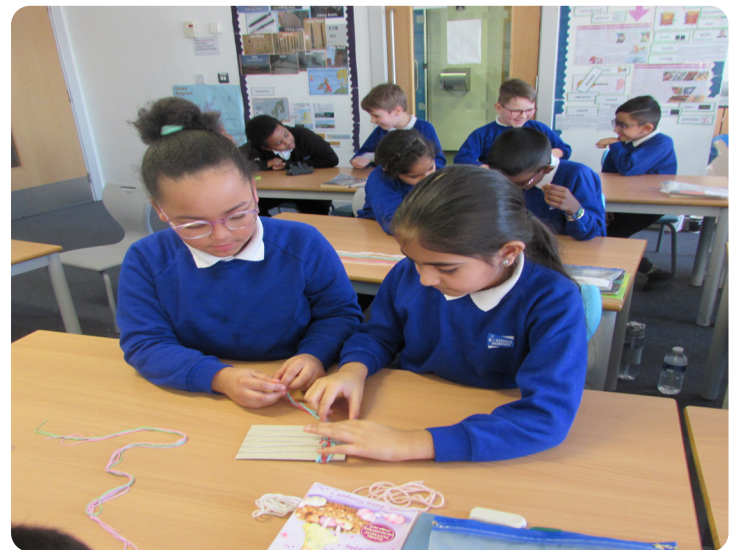
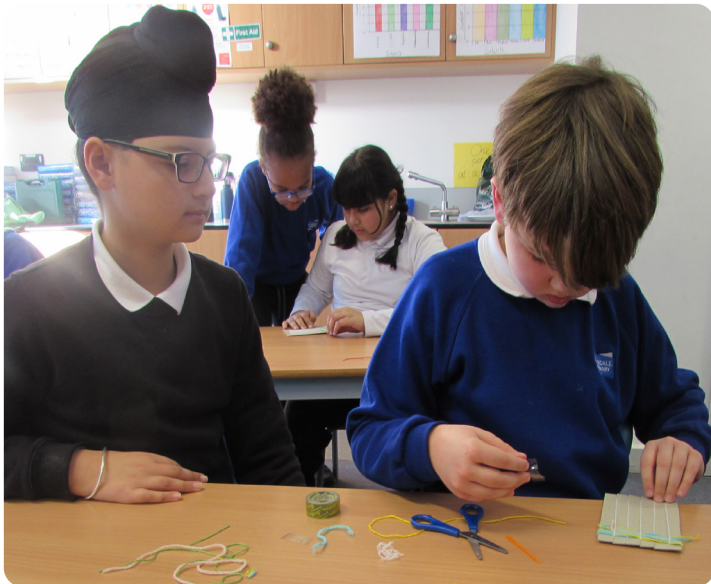




### Art Lesson - Year 4
