Key Focus:

MATHEMATICS

Key Focus:

In Mathematics children will review and consolidate

Written multiplication and multiplication of fractions. Use long multiplication.

Multiply and divide numbers mentally using known facts; express remainders as fractions; solve word problems; understand percentages as parts of 100; find simple %.

SCIENCE

Key Question:

What are life cycles? Do mammals have life cycles?

Living Things and their Habitats

This term children will learn about the life cycles of mammals. They will also explore the reproduction of plants.

Children will also learn about Metamorphosis and Comparing Life Cycles: To describe the differences in the life

cycles of an amphibian and an insect by exploring complete and incomplete metamorphosis.

GEOGRAPHY & HISTORY

Key Question:

History: Who was Mary Anning?

Children will be identifying changes related to simple scientific and historical ideas in the context of theories about fossils.

Geography: How were mountains made?

Children will describe and understand key aspects of physical geography, including: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes, and the water cycle in the context of mountains.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Key Question:

What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?

What does Ummah mean?

How was the Quran revealed?

What is the main belief for Sikhism?

PSHE

Key Focus:

Relationships:

Mutual Respect, tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs. Families and people who care for me- *Who are the members of my family?*

Caring and Friendships: *Who is my friend? How do I use the skills I have learnt to keep safe online?*

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY & ART

Key Focus:

Art: Children will use their skills learned in art to create fossils, sketch and draw. Children will create Metamorphosis through Art.

Design and Technology: Children will make a bridge with a variety of materials to see which can withstand masses and has the strongest design element.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Key Question:

What are my strengths and weaknesses in athletics?

Children will play competitive games and modify where necessary, they will apply basic skills for defending and attacking.
