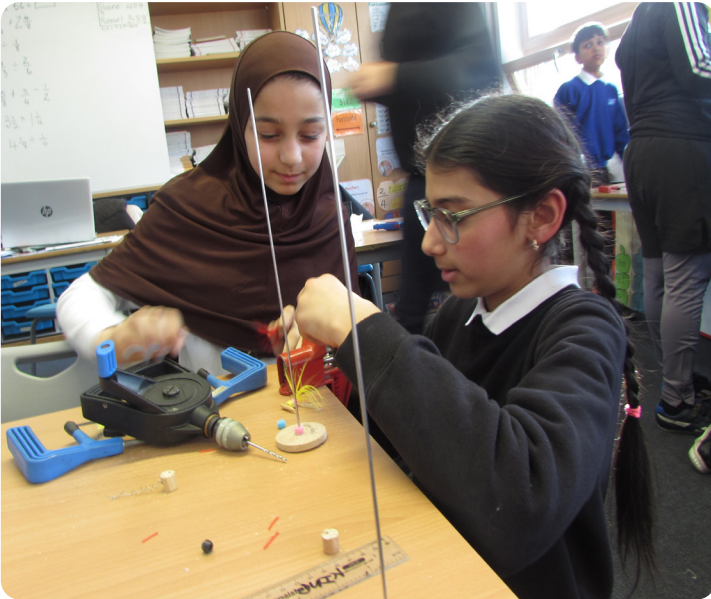
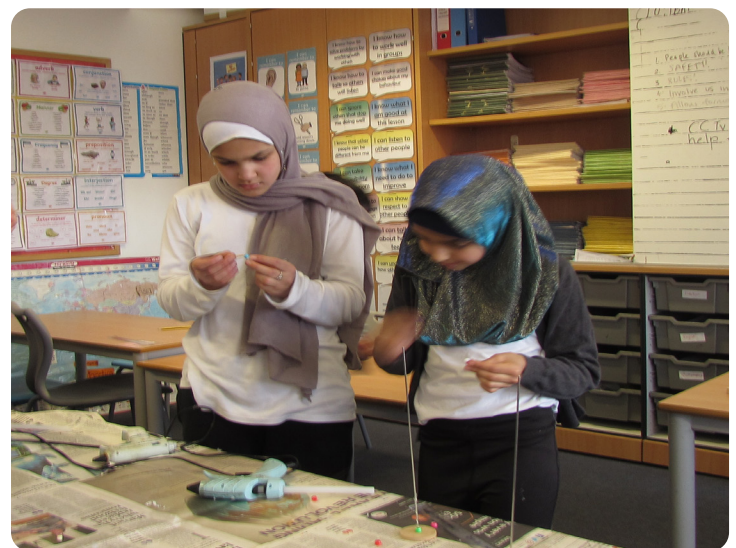
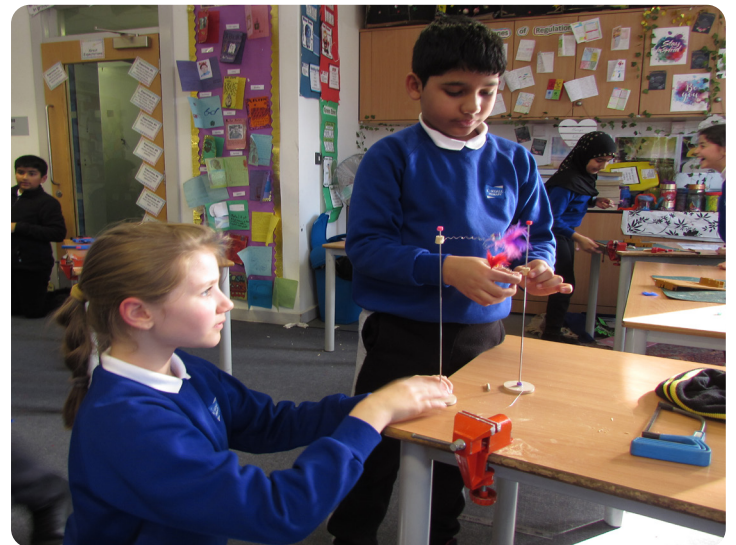




Tudor Toys Workshop
