

ENGLISH

Key Question:

What is journalistic writing?

Children will build their skills on writing non-chronological reports and journalistic writing.

Grammar Focus: Understanding active and passive, recognising direct and indirect speech, including punctuation.

Fiction Text: Harry Potter

MATHEMATICS

Children will read, interpret information in tables, connect their work on coordinates and scales to their interpretation of graphs.

Dividing decimals.

Geometry: Plotting, drawing shapes and labelling the shapes in the four quadrants.

Algebra: solve and find the missing number in the equations.

Key Questions: Why do materials change?

Children will work scientifically to find properties and changes in materials. Also they will study parts of the human circulatory system.

History Key Questions: Why did Henry VII seize the throne?

Geography Key Questions: Why are the Amazon settlements important? How are they connecting to the Amazon Basin?

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Key Questions: What matters most to Christians and Humanists? How do Hindus worship in their homes and why?

Explore the link in the book of (Genesis 1:28 about humans being made in the image of God. Also looking at the (Fall in Genesis 3) that humans are sinful. Looking at the Humanist code for living. Look at the two rules love God and love your neighbour in the Abrahamic Faiths.

PSHE

Good to be me. Rule of Law

Key Questions: How can I debate topical issues whilst maintaining respect? How can we show care even if we have no money?

Children will learn about Physical health and Fitness Healthy Eating.



DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY/Art

Key Question: What makes a great artist?

Children will work on increasing their mastery of art and design techniques including painting. They will research and compare techniques.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Key Question: How can I use basic movements and skills learnt to participate in various competitive games?

Children will use running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and combination to play competitive games. Children will develop, flexibility, strength and control.
