Black History Month - October 2023

Black History Month is the annual celebration and commemoration of moments in history, achievements and contributions that Black people have made. First brought to the UK in the 1980s, Black History Month was initially introduced to the country by a member of the Greater London Council, Akyaaba Addai Sebo. Since 1987, Black History Month has been celebrated annually in the UK, to help eradicate discrimination and encourage racial equality. At Rosedale Primary School, we will be honouring the contributions made to society by people of black heritage and their communities.

Bikeability Training

- Asthma action plans



To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications no later than Friday 27th October to ensure that it is received by the published deadline.
