ENGLISH

Key Question, How do we know our writing is Persuasive? Writing to entertain through debate, discussion and dialogue. Children will be able to present their opinions about zoos reflecting on the positive and the negative sides.

MATHEMATICS

Key Question: What is Geometry? Reading coordinates - Reading coordinates looking

- at axis x and y.
- Link coordinates to daily life and concrete contexts.
- Reading maps and use coordinates given to finding items/treasure maps. Drawing polygons using coordinates in four .quadrants. Read coordinates and plot points on grids using the four quadrants

SCIENCE

Animals Including Humans: Key Question: How does our digestion system work? We will learn about digestive system in humans, organs and body parts. Teeth and functions. Food chains and webs, diets of different animals – herbivore, carnivore and omnivore.

GEOGRAPHY & HISTORY

Geography Key Question: Human and physical Geography what is that? What are Rivers and settlements? Characteristics of rivers journey of a river, famous rivers in the world and their locations. The importance of rivers in human life. History Key Questions:

Where is the Indus Valley, Who were the Indus? Introduction to the Indus civilisation.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Key Questions: What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today? Who was Mahatma Ghandi? What similarities are there between Hindu worship and other faith worship? Children will learn about their commonalties about what faith teaches in values.

PSHE

Mutual Respect, working with those different beliefs and faiths, British Values: Relationships: Families and people who care for me-What are the similarities and differences between my family at school and at home?
