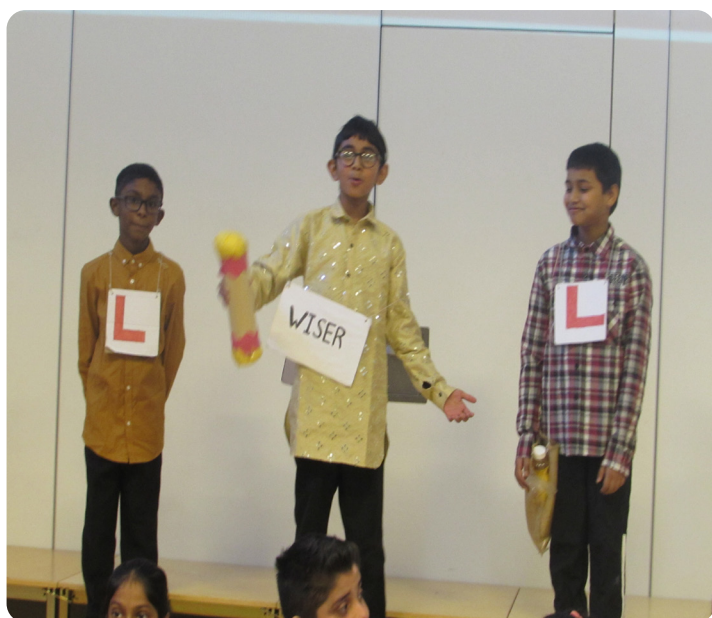
We would like to thank you all for your kind donations. This year, we raised a total of **£100** for Children in Need.
