



RECEPTION SUMMER ONE – WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD LEARN THIS HALF TERM?

Topic: People who help us

Key Question: How do we learn through play?



LITERACY

Focus will be placed on:

Labelling items and making lists based on the topic this term – People who help us. They will look at some simple report writing about what various people who help us do in order to help us.
Descriptive writing in regards to superheroes. And writing greetings and letters.

MATHEMATICS

Focus will be placed on:

Number bonds to 10, recapping addition to 10 and 20. Looking at comparing some measures such as height, length and weight. Children will also be introduced to coins – 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1 and £2. They will use them in practical activities to familiarise themselves with all these coins.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Pupils will be engaged in:

Finding out information about people who help us, what they do, what they wear, how we get in touch with them i.e 999. Talking to actual people who help us and asking their own questions.
Using computers and IPADS to take part in maths games.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

Pupils will be:

Creating crafts which relate to our topic, x-ray hands, superhero masks, dinosaur crafts and Eid and Ramadan crafts.

PERSONAL SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Children will be developing skills in:

Talking to visitors when they come to school and showing the correct behaviour and respect when others are talking. Looking at their confidence in talking to unfamiliar adults and asking questions of things they wish to know.
Children will have built their confidence in knowing when they do and do not need help and asking for the help they do need in full sentences. Also they will be looking at showing sensitivity towards others and supporting their peers with their needs.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Pupils will be engaged in:
Writing sentences and forming letters correctly. Team games and ball skills In PE.



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

Focus will be placed on:

Relevant topic words and vocabulary to help broaden the children's knowledge based on people who help us such as police, doctors, ambulance staff, vets, radiographers. Having visits from these people will also help the children to use the topic vocabulary on a more fluent basis.

PHONICS SOUNDS & TRICKY WORDS

Focus will be placed on:

Recapping initial sounds and digraphs.

Tricky words: me, we, be, he, she, was, you, they, are.

Looking at sentence formation, rhyming words, reading comprehension and word endings such as ing.
