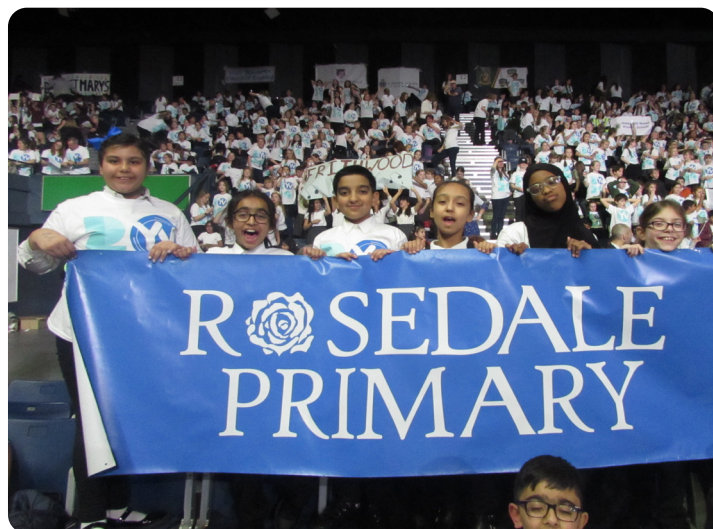
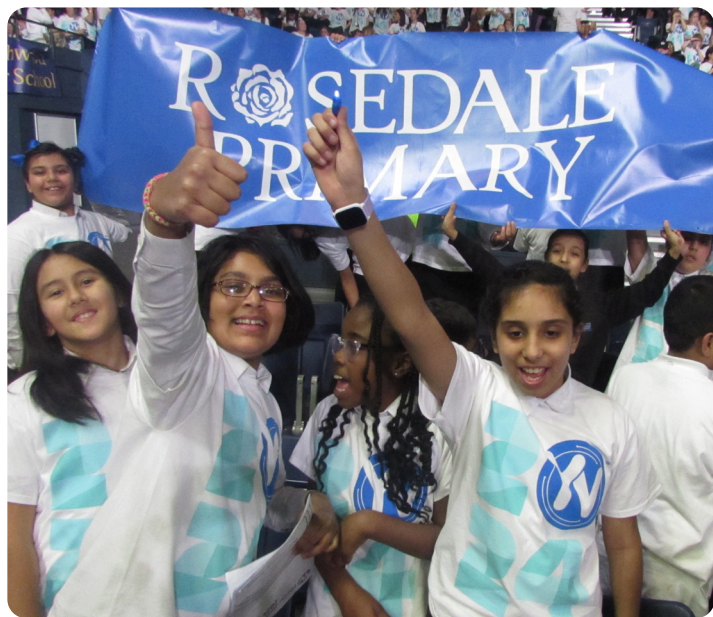


Young Voices Concert
