ENGLISH

Key Questions? What is a script? Are plays fiction and non-fiction?

Children will learn about writing to entertain an audience.

Children will learn about the features of plays. They will learn to edit their work and create humour in their writing. They will understand the importance of past and present through tenses.

MATHEMATICS

Key Question: How can we remember to partition?

Multiplication: : Dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers using partitioning, expanded written, formal written. Division word problems. Children will learn to work independently and use the best method to solve problems.

SCIENCE

Key Question:Animals and Humans, what are food chains? Why do humans have responsibility for this? Children will learn about predators and how they affect the food chain.
