



RECEPTION SUMMER TWO – WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD LEARN THIS HALF TERM?

Topic: Journeys Key Question: How can we transition into Key stage 1?



LITERACY

Focus will be placed on:

Writing full sentences independently, writing the date and title on our work and using connectives in our writing. Writing recounts of familiar stories or making up our own stories. Looking at various modes of travel and transport and making some lists.

MATHEMATICS

Focus will be placed on:

Using coins for simple addition and subtraction. Writing them in number sentences and using them in role play.

Children will be looking at items that float and sink and comparing why this happens. Looking at capacity of various items and using vocabulary such as full, nearly full, half full, nearly empty, empty. Positional language such as under, on top of etc and an introduction into time using o'clock and half past.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Pupils will be engaged in:

Looking at different modes of transport and travel, thinking about how we come to school and if this is good for our environment. Changes in the world and how we can help save our planet Earth.

How transport and travel has changed over time comparing the past to the present.

Looking at different countries, their flags and other ways countries differ from where we live.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

Pupils will be:

Making maps, happy earth crafts and various crafts to represent different countries we look at.

PERSONAL SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Children will be developing skills in:

Preparing for a change of class and key stage, talking about our feelings of confidence and what to do when we feel overwhelmed or worried. Find ways to support ourselves and our friends. Reflect upon our time in Reception, what we enjoyed, the friends we have made and how we are excited for our changes.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Pupils will be engaged in:
Writing sentences and forming letters correctly. Competitive games in PE for mini sports day.



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

Focus will be placed on:

Relevant topic words and vocabulary to help broaden the children's knowledge based on journeys. Looking at holidays and reflecting on our time in reception before moving up to Year 1.

PHONICS SOUNDS & TRICKY WORDS

Focus will be placed on:

Recapping initial sounds, digraphs, spelling of tricky words and high frequency words.

Answering questions in reading comprehension, identifying digraphs and finishing sentences with correct words.
