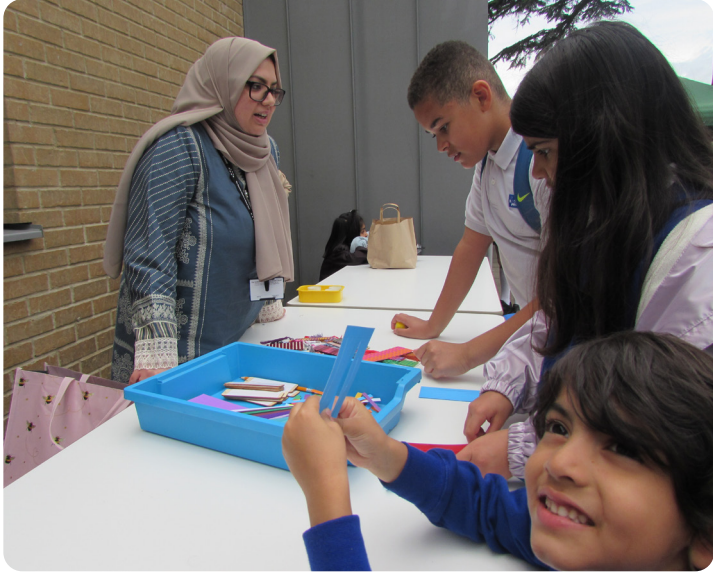


## Rosedale Primary Summer Fair!
