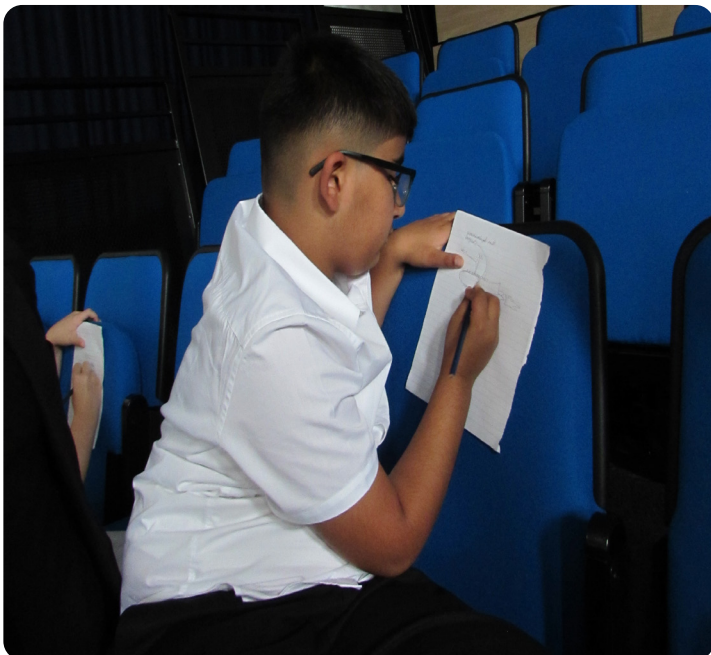
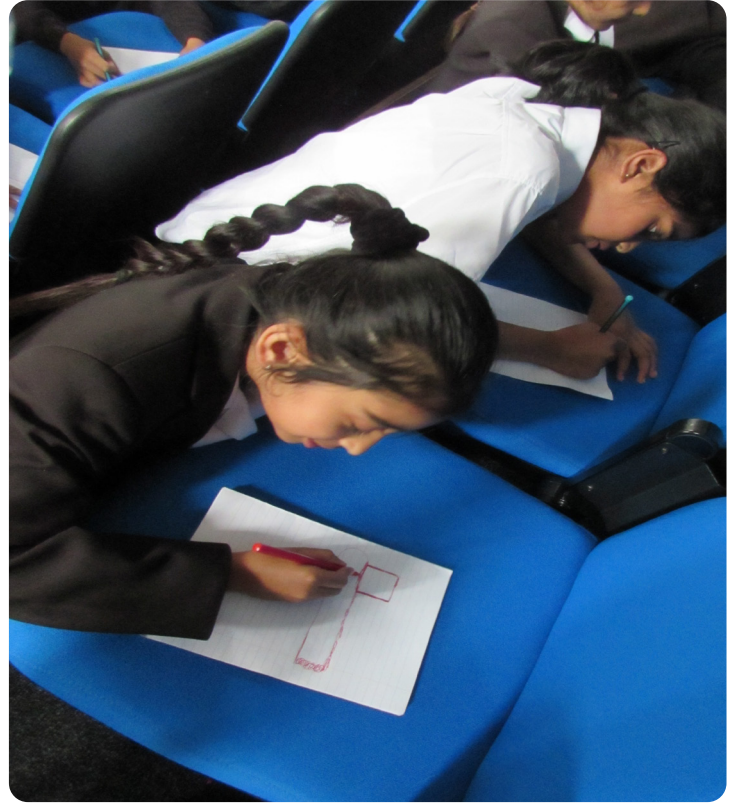
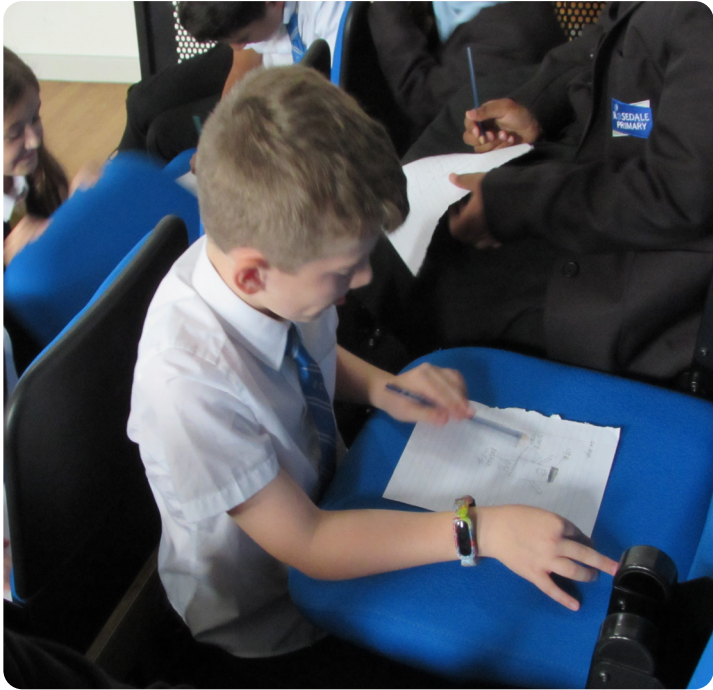




## STEM with Wings
