



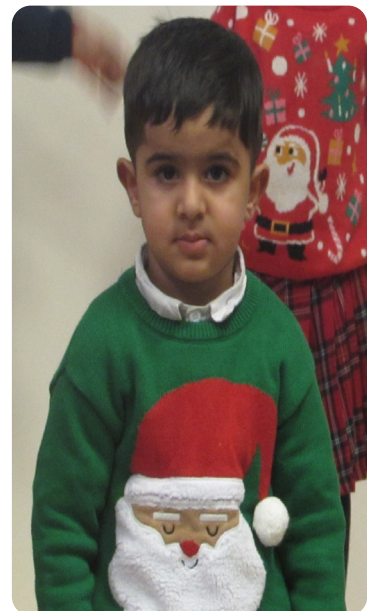
## Santa Giving Out Presents
