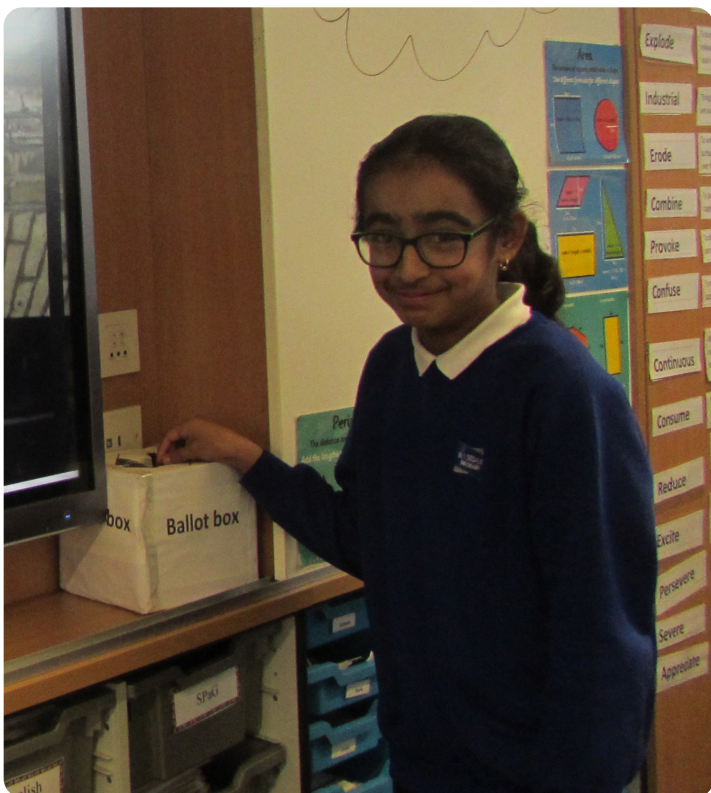
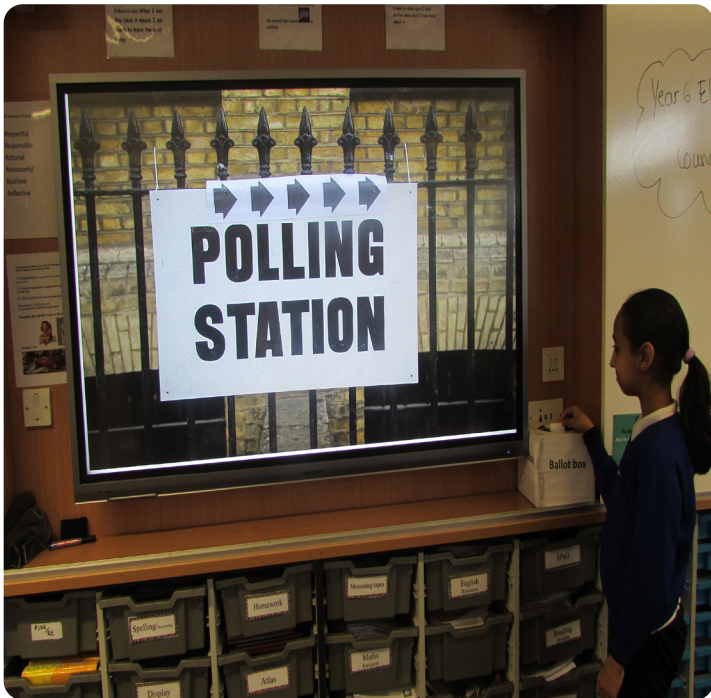
## Phonics Workshop – Nursery
