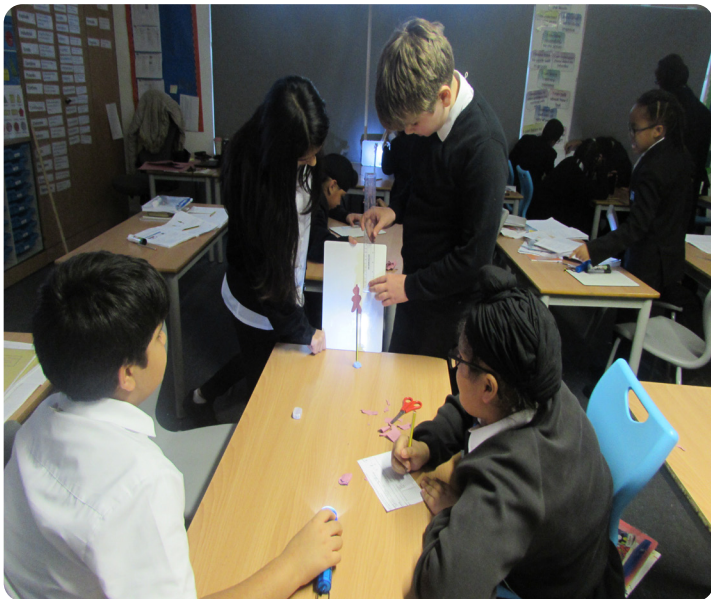
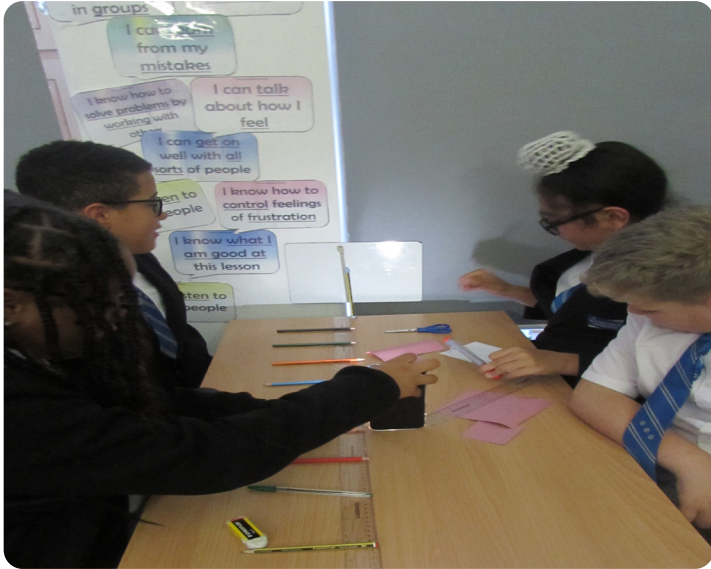




Light and Reflection Investigation - Year 6

Year 6 pupils engaged in a science experiment to create a working periscope and explain how the periscope allows them to see objects they would not usually be able to see. Children enjoyed the investigation and were able to discuss and share their findings and record these using diagrams and scientific language.
