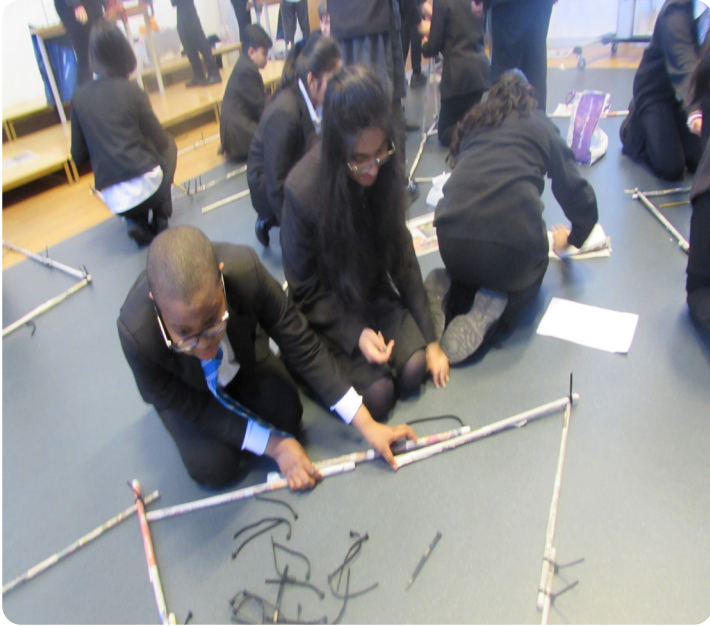
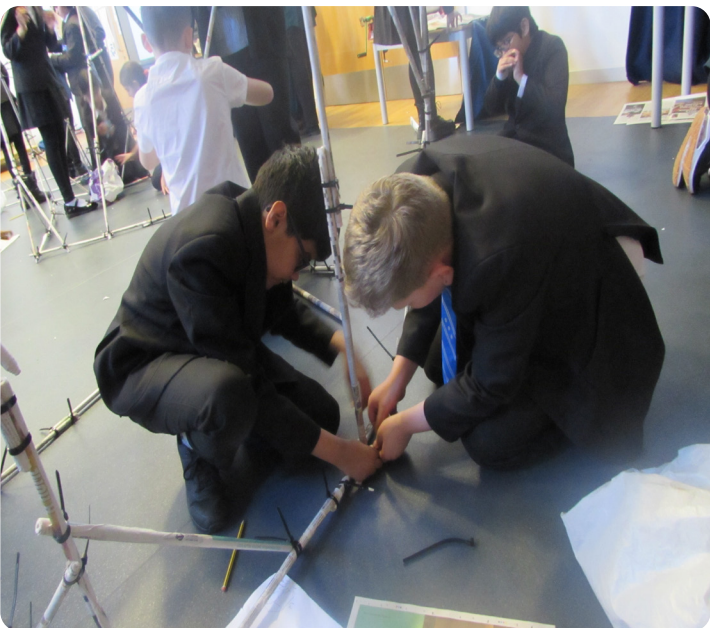
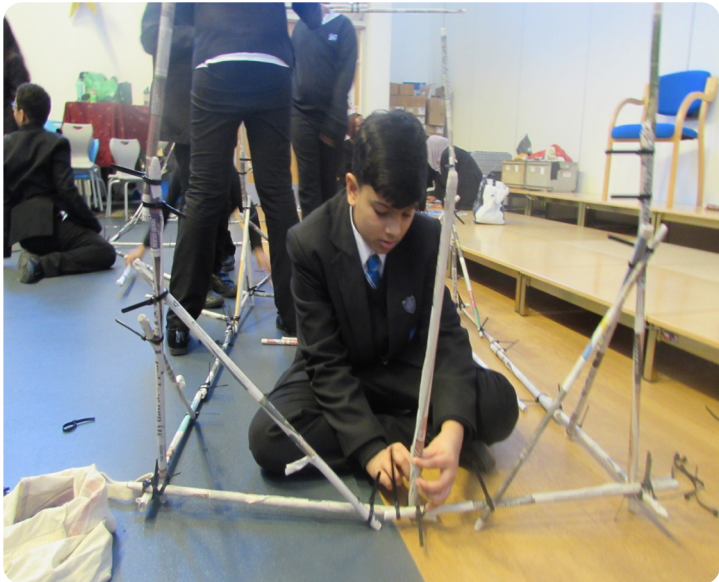
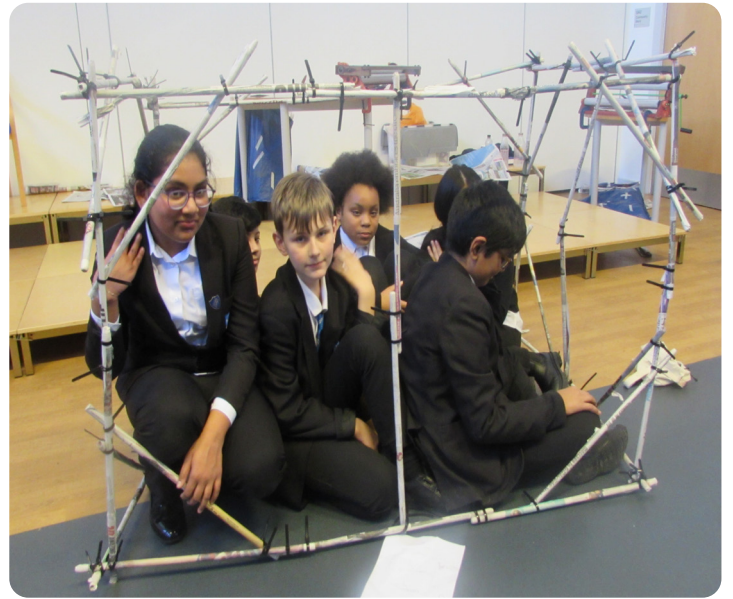
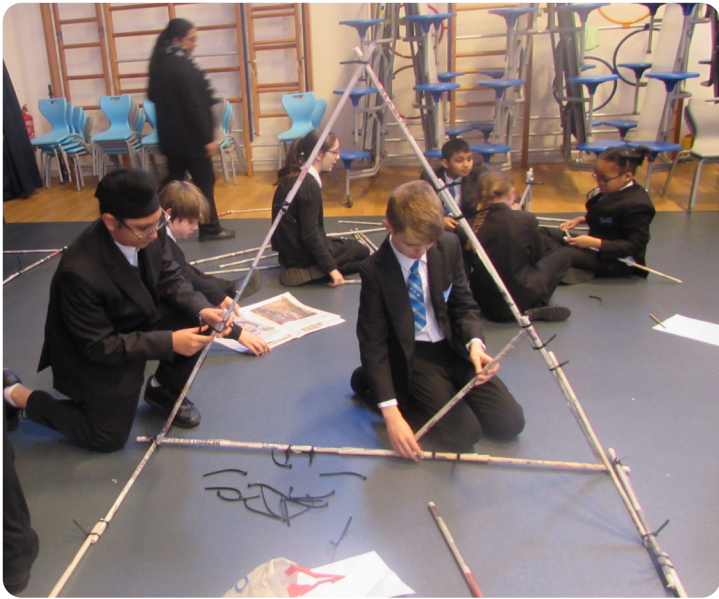
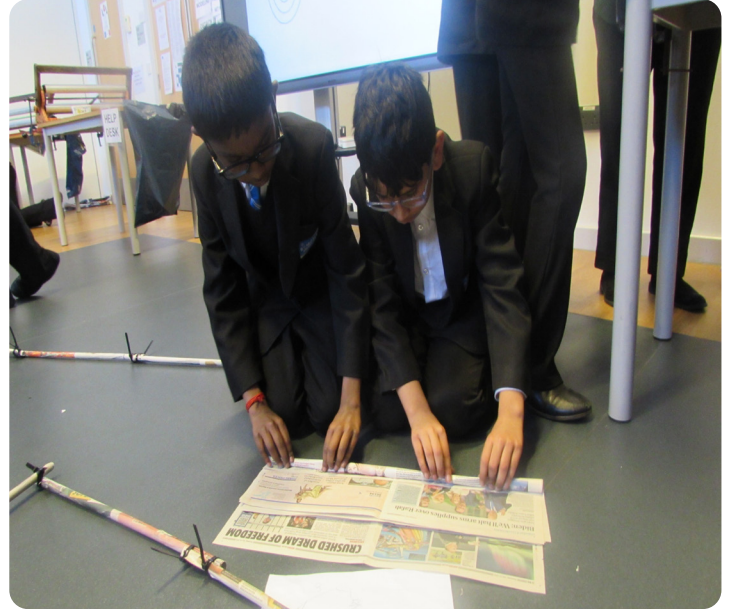
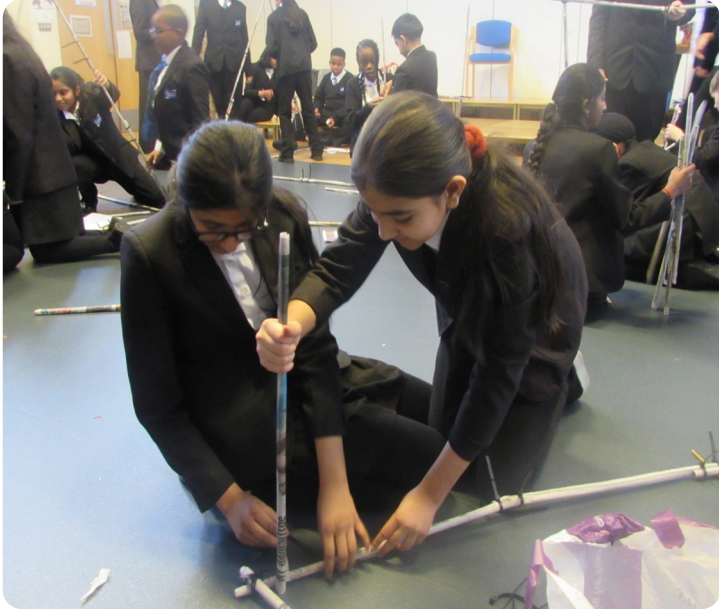


## STIXX Workshop

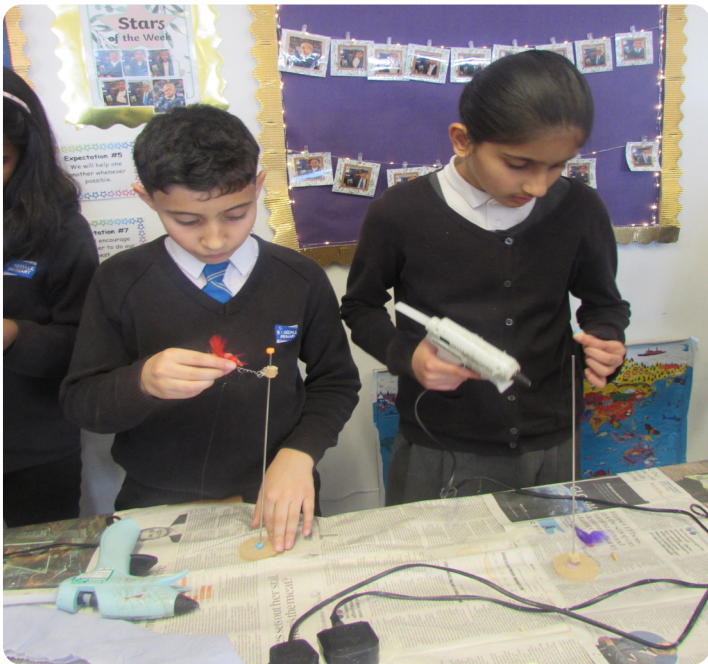
## Hand Crafts

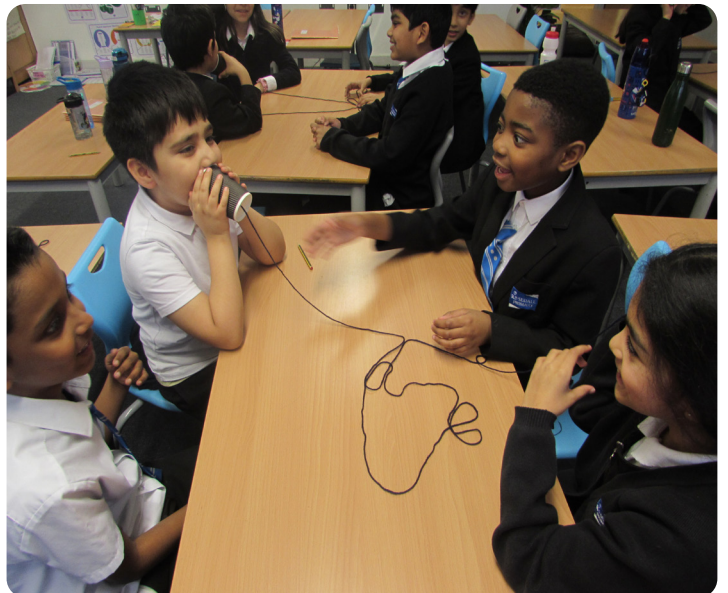
## Tudor Toys Workshop

On Thursday 27th February, the Year 5 pupils took part in a Tudor Toys Workshop which saw them make a woodpecker toy that moved down a thin pole. The pupils learnt about different aspects of Science, Engineering, Mathematics and Technology in order to create these toys. They all thoroughly enjoyed making their beautifully coloured individual woodpeckers and were very excited to show off their hard work to all their friends, parents, guardians and carers!



## Sound Experiment

The Year 4 pupils studied the topic of Sound during the Spring 1 term. In one of the lessons, they investigated how sound travels through solids by creating and testing string telephones. Additionally, they designed and executed an investigation to determine which material best reduces sound. The pupils worked in small groups to prepare various materials for lining the interior of boxes. Subsequently, they covered a sound source with each box and measured the decibel levels using an application. With guidance, the pupils were able to identify and control the variables in their experiment, ensuring its fairness. They recorded the results of their investigation and used these results to draw conclusions.
