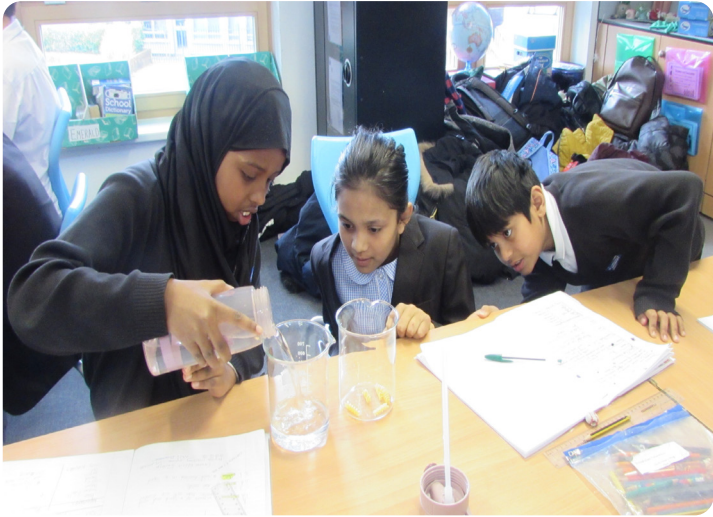


British Science Week

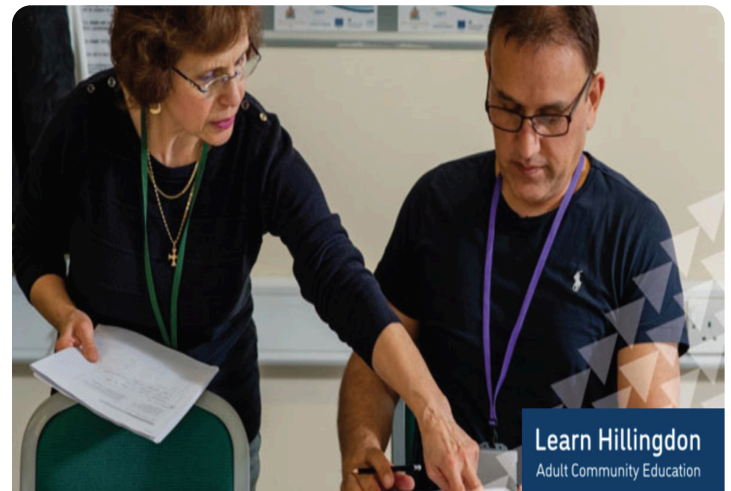
Look Out Discovery Trip
