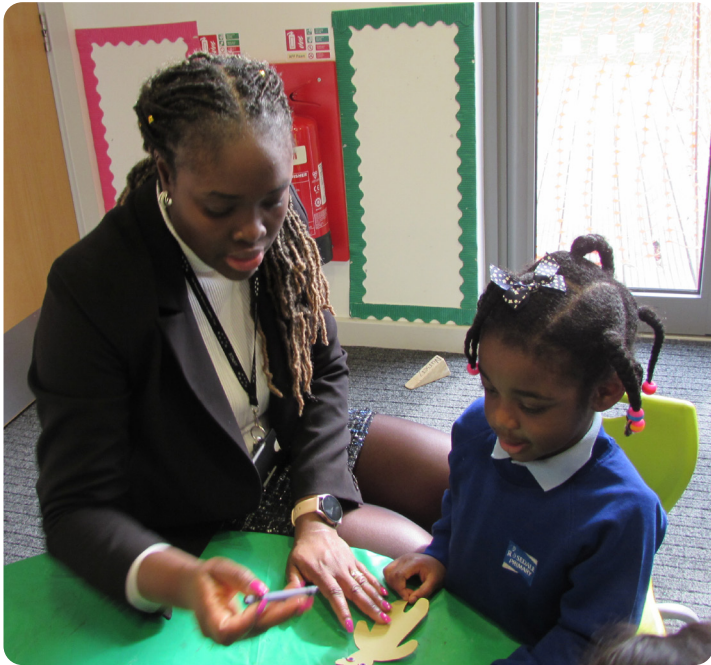




Reception and Nursery Stay and Play

Keeping our Community Safe

As a school, we have an ongoing commitment to making sure all of our children are kept safe in and out of school. With this in mind, we would like to ensure that all our children are aware of the importance of not speaking to or approaching anyone that is unknown to them. Therefore, when collecting and dropping your children off, as it is often a busy time and the site and surrounding areas become crowded, please ensure you have your child in sight at all times. If your child is in Year 6 and travels to school independently, you may wish to provide them with a mobile phone for reasons of personal safety. It is the policy of the School for all pupils to hand their mobile phones in to the School Office upon arrival where it will be securely stored until the end of the day when they must be collected by the pupils.

Year 6 SATs – Monday 12th to Thursday 15th May

From Monday 12th to Thursday 15th May the pupils in Year 6 will be sitting their SATs exams. They will be sitting the following papers:

LEngish grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2	Monday 12th May
English Reading	Tuesday 13th May
Mathematics papers 1 and 2	Wednesday 14th May
Mathematics paper 3	Thursday 15th May

It is absolutely essential that your child is in school during this week and on time as the exams will start promptly in the morning. Please ensure that your child is well rested and has eaten a good breakfast as this will allow them to do the best that they can.

Please note that after the SATs have finished, the Year 6 pupils will continue to sit assessments throughout June and July, therefore they must continue to attend school as normal. Thank you.

Booster Mornings - Monday 7th and Tuesday 8th April

On Monday 7th and Tuesday 8th April, we will be running booster mornings for those pupils who have been sent an invitation. This is from 9:00am to 12:30pm. Pupils can come in their own clothes and will need to be provided with a snack and water bottle. Thank you.
