

The Look Out Discovery Centre Trip – Year 2

On Friday 2nd May 2025, our Year 2 pupils embarked on an exciting adventure to The Look Out Discovery Centre in Bracknell. The trip was packed with hands-on activities that brought science to life in the most engaging way! From launching rockets and experimenting with forces to exploring the light and sound zones, pupils were able to apply their classroom learning in a real-world setting.

They also enjoyed interactive exhibits that demonstrated the power of water, air and movement, making scientific concepts fun and accessible. Beyond science, the day included time outdoors, where pupils explored the natural surroundings, spotting wildlife and learning about habitats and ecosystems. It was wonderful to see their enthusiasm as they made connections between what they've studied in class and the world around them. Mathematics papers 1 and 2	Wednesday 14th May
Mathematics paper 3	Thursday 15th May

It is absolutely essential that your child is in school during this week and on time as the exams will start promptly in the morning. Please ensure that your child is well rested and has eaten a good breakfast as this will allow them to do the best that they can.

Please note that after the SATs have finished, the Year 6 pupils will continue to sit assessments throughout June and July, therefore they must continue to attend school as normal.
