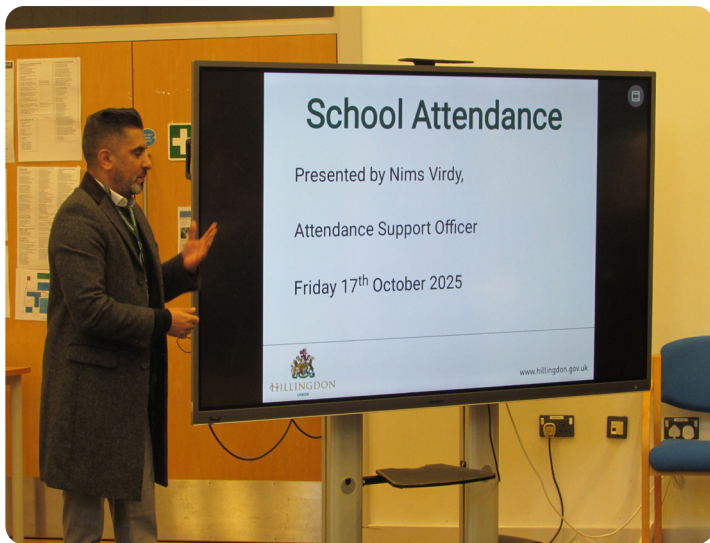




Coffee Morning – Thank You for Joining Us!

Pedestrian Training – Year 4

On Monday 13th October, Year 4 pupils took part in Pedestrian Training delivered by the STARs team. The pupils were split into small groups and learnt about the different hazards on the roads as well as how to keep themselves safe when walking on the pavements and crossing roads, particularly busy ones. Once they had received their initial training, the children ventured out onto the local roads around the School campus to put into practice all they had learnt. It was an invaluable experience for the pupils as they witnessed some of the hazards first-hand and felt confident in knowing what they needed to do to keep safe. We hope that by taking part in the Pedestrian Training, this will encourage more pupils to travel to school sustainably (walking, biking, scooting etc.) as they will feel more confident about travelling along our roads.



School Leader Elections

On Friday 3rd October the Year 6 pupils casted their votes for the next school leaders of Rosedale Primary school. The children who wanted to stand for election gave speeches to the other children outlining what they stand for and what they would like to achieve as a leader. The children then took part in a democratic vote, writing the name of those who they would like to elect and post it in our ballot box. The children will be eagerly awaiting the results of the election which will be announced very soon.



Year 6 Bikeability – 10th November to 13th November

Year 6 students will have the opportunity to take part in Bikeability training, which promotes safe cycling skills. However, unlike previous years, the Bikeability team will not be able to provide the Dr Bike service this time. This service usually involves checking the children's bikes to ensure they are safe and in good working order. Instead, they have provided us with a link to a video that guides you through checking your child's bike at home. This will help you identify and make any necessary repairs before the training. 
