

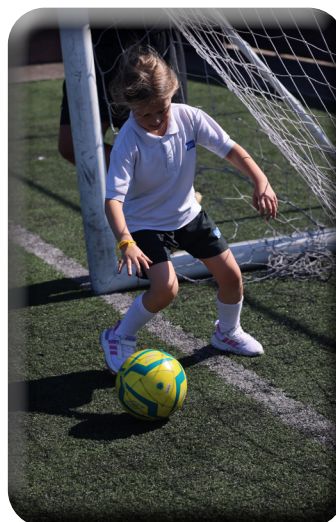
Year 1 and 2 Sports Day
